## **SECTION 1.08 - PROSECUTION AND PROGRESS**

### **Article 1.08.04 - Limitation of Operations - Add the following:**

In order to provide for traffic operations as outlined in the Special Provision "Maintenance and Protection of Traffic," the Contractor will not be permitted to perform any work which will interfere with the described traffic operations on all project roadways as follows:

#### **Interstate 684**

The Contractor shall not perform any work that will interfere with traffic operations during the below State observed Legal Holidays and Legal Holiday Periods.

A. On the following State observed Legal Holidays:

New Year's Day	Labor Day
Good Friday	Thanksgiving Day
Memorial Day	Christmas Day
Independence Day	

B. During the following Legal Holiday Periods:

- i. When an above Legal Holiday is celebrated on a Sunday or Monday: From 6:00 a.m. the immediately preceding Friday to 6:00 a.m. the immediately following Tuesday.
- ii. When an above Legal Holiday is celebrated on a Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday: From 6:00 a.m. the day before to 6:00 a.m. the day after, except Thanksgiving (see below for Thanksgiving specific restrictions).
- iii. When an above Legal Holiday is celebrated on a Friday or Saturday: From 6:00 a.m. the immediately preceding Thursday to 6:00 a.m. the immediately following Monday.
- iv. Thanksgiving: From 6:00 a.m. the Wednesday before to 6:00 a.m. the Monday after.

During all other times:

- A. The Contractor shall maintain and protect traffic as shown on the Lane Closure Charts shown on the plans, which dictate the minimum number of lanes to remain open.
- B. The Contractor will be allowed to close lanes as shown on the Lane Closure Charts shown on the plans during non crossover weekends to facilitate the construction and removal of the crossovers.

Additional Restrictions:

- A. During the rehabilitation of New York State Bridge No. 1052991, the Contractor shall implement a temporary crossover that maintains two lanes of traffic on I-684 Southbound onto Connecticut Bridge No. 03514. To allow for the crossover, I-684 Northbound shall be reduced to two lanes of traffic per 1.08.03.
- B. During the rehabilitation of Connecticut Bridge No. 03514, the Contractor shall implement a temporary crossover that maintains two lanes of traffic on I-684 Northbound onto New York State Bridge No. 1052991. To allow for the crossover, I-684 Southbound shall be reduced to two lanes of traffic per 1.08.03.

- C. The Contractor shall notify the Engineer at least 14 days in advance of the start of each crossover.

**Interstate 684 Ramps**

Monday through Friday between 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. & between 3:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.

**Additional Lane Closure Restrictions**

It is anticipated that work on adjacent projects will be ongoing simultaneously with this project. The Contractor shall be aware of those projects and anticipate that coordination will be required to maintain proper traffic flow at all times on all project roadways, in a manner consistent with these specifications and acceptable to the Engineer.

The Contractor will not be allowed to perform any work that will interfere with traffic operations on a roadway when traffic operations are being restricted on that same roadway, unless there is at least a one mile clear area length where the entire roadway is open to traffic or the closures have been coordinated and are acceptable to the Engineer. The one mile clear area length shall be measured from the end of the first work area to the beginning of the signing pattern for the next work area.
